Introduction

"Medical Korea Academy Global" is a training program provided by the Korea Health Industry Development Institute(KHIDI), where the Institute invites medical practitioners from various countries to participate. This program is to provide the trainees with an opportunity to learn about Korea's advanced medical knowledge and technology, as well as improve their understanding of, and preference for, Korean medical services. We look forward to the participation and support of medical practitioners (outside Korea) who are interested in the program.

Eligibilities

- ① **A licensed doctor with at least 5 years of clinical practice in one of the specialties listed below**

Specialties

Internal Medicine, General Surgery, Orthopedics, Neurosurgery, Thoracic & Cardiovascular surgery, Anesthesiology, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pediatrics, Ophthalmology, Otorhinolaryngology, Urology, Radiation Oncology, Dentistry, Plastic surgery, etc.

- ② **A person who have a visible plan to develop the healthcare cooperative project with Korean hospital**

* Only available for those who have recommendation letter from the Korean hospital

Required Documents

All the documents should be in English. If not, it should be notarized prior to the submission.

Program Schedule

- Trainees have to arrive in Korea before starting the orientation
- Trainees are recommended to depart Korea right after the Completion ceremony.

Brief Description of Training Program

1. Arrival

- KHIDI provides pick-up services at the airport and assistance with hotel reservation during the orientation period.
- In principle, only the accommodation expenses for the day before the orientation shall be covered. Any additional accommodation expenses should be paid for by the trainee.

2. Online Pre-Training (MKA e-class)

- KHIDI provide online pre-training(MKA e-class) for the trainees.
- Submit a certificate of completion after completing the course that selected a curriculum related to the training department before the completion ceremony. **(Notification after)**

< Curriculum >

- Surgical Skills Education (Hepatobiliary & Pancreatic surgery, Gastrointestinal surgery, Colorectal surgery, Breast & Thyroid, Trauma & Surgical Critical Care, and Surgical Emergency)
- Internal medicine skills(Echocardiography, Endoscopic, Infection Control),
 - Non-clinical Education (Medical ICT, Hospital Management)
- Dentistry Education (Prosthodontics, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery)

3. Orientation and Opening Ceremony

- The trainees shall learn Korean (basic/medical terms), Korean healthcare system, Korean culture and medical law before the main training.

4. Hospital Training at Korean Medical Institutions

- Medical institutions provide training customized for the trainees.
- Each trainee is required to prepare and submit a final report and complete a satisfaction survey.

5. Completion Ceremony

- Each participants will receive a completion certificate (given by the president of KHIDI), and one or two trainees will share their review of the training program(selected by KHIDI).
- Certification will be given only to the trainees who have completed the entire program.

6. Departure

- If asked by the trainee, KHIDI shall assist the trainee with hotel reservation and lift to the airport for departure.
- The accommodation expense for Completion ceremony shall be covered by KHIDI. Any additional accommodation expenses should be paid by the trainee.
